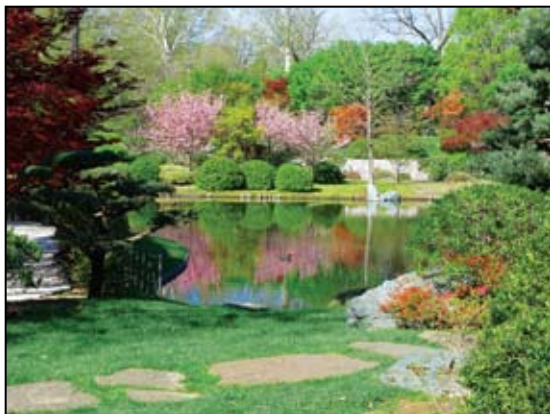
## Ground Transportation
